



LANI Project: Peck Park Canyon Conceptual Plan Project

Project Area: Peck Park Canyon, 31-acre undeveloped portion of Peck Park

Project Summary: Los Angeles Neighborhood Initiative (LANI) was selected by the City of Los Angeles, the Northwest San Pedro Neighborhood Council and the Peck Park Advisory Board to facilitate a conceptual planning and design project for Peck Park Canyon. LANI's process is designed to achieve community consensus on a plan for Peck Park Canyon that will serve as a catalyst to launch future project area clean-up, design and construction of improvements.

A key component of LANI's process is the active participation of a steering committee of local stakeholders established by LANI and the Office of Councilwoman Janice Hahn. The steering committee will serve multiple roles throughout the project: selecting a design team (Mia Lehrer + Associates selected in May 2004); representing the views of the broader community; making substantive decisions on proposed improvements; and garnering consensus in the community for final approval of the conceptual use plan. Throughout the project, community meetings will be held in order to solicit community input, provide project updates and gain consensus for proposed elements. LANI, the steering committee, Mia Lehrer + Associates and a project team of government advisors will work closely together, and with the greater community, to ensure that the proposed conceptual use plan reflects the community's vision for Peck Park Canyon. Completion of the project is anticipated in Fall/Winter 2004.
