Northwest San Pedro Neighborhood Council Report
September 12, 2016

I. Vacation

- a. I will be on vacation starting Friday, October 14, 2016 and will be returning Tuesday, November 8, 2016. During this time, if you need assistance please call 310.732.4515.

II. Highpark Update:

- a. Grading is almost finished. After grading is complete we will begin to see inground infrastructure being installed.
- b. At the same time, iStar is working with LADWP and CalTrans on water/power service to the area. They anticipate vertical construction commencing in March 2017.

III. Northwest Resurfacing/Slurry Seal, July 2016:

- a. Barhugh PI between Bolker PI and Casey PI
- b. Stonewood Ct between cul-de-sac to Dalmatia Dr
- c. Mt. Shasta Dr between Westmont Dr and Stonewood Ct
- d. Taper Ave between Barhugh PI and Eastman PI
- e. Gatun St from cul-de-sac to N. Cabrillo Ave
- f. N. Leland St between W. Elberon Ave and W. Summerland Ave

IV. Northwest Resurfacing/Slurry Seal, September 2016:

- a. W. 16th St between S. Leland St and S. Walker Ave
- b. S. Leland St between W. 8th St and W. 9th St and between W. 10th St and W. 11th St.

V. Los Angeles Sister Cities Plaza (Exit Park)

- a. Construction is well underway. We anticipate construction concluding and a Grand Opening/Ribbon cutting in 6-8 weeks.

VI. Downtown San Pedro Courthouse

- a. Courthouse sale to Los Angeles County has been approved by the CA State Legislature and signed by Governor Brown.
- b. LA County released an RFP for the property in late July; interested bidders attended a conference on August 8, 2016; proposals are due by 2pm on September 27, 2016.
- c. LA County has a goal to select a developer by November 01, 2016.
- d. After a developer is selected, community meetings will commence to solicit input and develop a draft design to review with all stakeholders.

- e. CD15 will continue to collaborate with the 4th District LA County Supervisor on this project to keep stakeholders apprised of developments and timeline.

VII. Legislative Update

a. Sidewalk Repair Incentive Program

1. We are continuing to push to get the sidewalk rebate program online, hopefully by this fall.
2. When that program is ready, my office will be promoting this incentive program for those property owners who wish to be proactive with regards to sidewalk repair.
3. In addition to the sidewalk program, the city's online and phone system will also take requests from residents with disabilities to have their sidewalks repaired.
4. This program is currently pending before the Los Angeles City Council, and is anticipated to be approved soon.
