### **1. Update on last NC Presidents Meeting with the Port of Los Angeles**

Carlos Garcia gave an update on the NC Presidents meeting with Port of Los Angeles representatives. Primary discussion was around the letter the NC Board submitted to the Port regarding the transport of hazardous materials on the rail within the Port. Committee agreed to follow up with Port at next meeting to see if schedule could be provided. Carlos and Pat updated committee on EIR update for China Shipping. Committee was disappointed that our comments related to lighting and noise were not addressed in the revised EIR. Committee did discuss the Port adding sidewalk / curbs around Knoll Hill on Harbor Boulevard, on both sides of the street. Committee to follow up on this project with the Port.

### **2. Discussion on Community Projects**

Discussed the Sampson Way / Harbor Boulevard roadway improvement project and future community funding. The Sampson Way interchange is nearing completion. Discussed the future alignment of Harbor Boulevard and a potential transportation project the Port is looking in the Ports of Call area to follow on after the Sampson Way project is completed. Committee will follow up with Port to gain more detail on the proposed project and how it relates to the community funding allocation.

Carlos discussed the community funding and that the Port is starting to discuss the next five / ten-year cycle of funding for community projects. A review of the funding and spending on community projects shows the Port is pretty much on track with what was projected when the community funding began. The Port committee is looking ahead to future projects that might of interest to the community once the first cycle of community projects is completed.

### **3. Discussion of Clean Air Action Plan**

The committee followed up on the comments provided to the updated Clean Air Action Plan (CAAP). Committee discussed zero and near zero equipment and potential impacts on Port development and jobs. Carlos indicated that the Environmental Manager at the Port of Los Angeles, Chris Gannon, offered to come to NC or Port Committee meeting to discuss the CAAP.

Committee will follow up on CAAP and potential presentation with by the Port of Los Angeles. The committee will coordinate on this issue with the NC Sustainability Committee.

**4. Public Comment on items not on the agenda**

Short discussion on Ports of Call Development. Pat Nave gave update on Ports of Call development. Indicated that tenants at had been given notices to vacate. Phil expressed concern that the development is lagging. Pat and Carlos Garcia have been trying to engage the developer and have them come to a NC meeting to discuss the project and schedule. The committee will follow up again next month.
