The Northwest San Pedro Neighborhood Council **SUPPORTS** The Crazy Fish Grill and Restaurant's application for a license to serve beer and wine in conjunction with meal service. Crazy Fish, located at 28158 S. Western in San Pedro is expected to be a welcome addition to San Pedro, mixing both a restaurant and fish market.

The proposed restaurant will be a casual fresh seafood restaurant with a small fresh fish case. Meals are anticipated to be in the \$10-\$11 price range. It is our understanding that there will be no off-site sale of beer and wine and no separate bar area. Food will be sold during all operating hours, 11 am to 10 pm. The restaurant will seat 49 inside with approximately 10 seats outside. They are opening up the entire façade to windows as it faces the driveway from Westmont.

Tomnsello owns the second largest seafood wholesaler on the West Coast. They have formed a new corporation with several partners and their eventual goal is to create franchises with San Pedro being their "flag ship" operation. We wish this new business great success and expect it to make a positive contribution to our community.
