2018 SELECTION CANDIDATE GUIDELINES

- Candidates are encouraged to use a variety of tools and methods to promote their candidacy provided they are not in violation of these guidelines.
- Candidates shall not use the City of Los Angeles Seal or Letterhead, the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment Logo, the Office of the City Clerk Logo, nor the Northwest San Pedro Neighborhood Council Logo or Letterhead.
- Any written material paid for by anyone other than the candidate must identify the source of funds.
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- Candidates shall not receive endorsements from the governing Board of the Neighborhood Council.
- Candidates may receive endorsements from individual Board members, acting as individual stakeholders.
- Candidates shall not use City facilities, equipment, supplies or other City resources for campaigning activities.
- Candidates shall not engage in negative campaigning (“mudslinging”) during the campaign.
- Candidates shall not post fliers on public property. You must observe the posting laws in Sec 28/04 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code.
- No one shall engage in electioneering within 100 feet of the Polling Place on s/election day.
- Any illegal or fraudulent activity may be reported to the Neutral Third Party (NTP).
- Candidates shall notify the Board if their stakeholder status changes. Note, depending on the circumstances this could disqualify you from the seat you are seeking.
- Candidates may not run for more than one seat during this election.
