Northwest San Pedro Neighborhood Council Report
April 09, 2018

I. Harbor Highlands Park Hours

- a. On February 6, 2018, Councilman Buscaino introduced a Motion to officially establish park hours as sunrise to sunset, and to be added the list of parks closed at various times as specified by LAMC 63.44.
- b. The Los Angeles City Council will vote on recommendations to approve this Motion this coming Wednesday, April 11, 2018.
- c. After Council approval, it will go to the Board of Recreation and Parks Commission for approval as well.
- d. This is a technical addendum to the list, to ensure that the hours for the park can be adequately enforced.

II. Rancho San Pedro Redevelopment

- a. The RSP RFP received a total of 4 responses. HACLA and members of the community are in the process of evaluating the responses, and will determine which development firms will move on to the second phase.
- b. Developer selection is expected to be made by July 2018.
