Crime Stats: There has been increased activity at Target with Car campers over night and RV's. There is also a return of several encampments in the waterways- Community gardens area, across from Target in the Railway area and back at the World Port area across from Home Depot. They have cut the fence for railway in several places and a safety concern for community because they are all armed and for derailments.

Safety Issues with Peck Park and Harbor Highlands Park:

There are no Park rangers for the Harbor Highland Park and lax enforcement of rules and permits. There are many individuals abusing the park with no permits and abusive to community members and families trying to use park. There has been several vehicles driving on lawn and breaking locks for the poles to get into the park. There are issues with LAPD responding to people in the park after hours because of no signs posted. The signs were removed for fence painting and never returned. Peck Park Canyons were cleaned out of encampments and they all disbursed in railway/ water shed area of North Gaffey Street.
