Summary: The Northwest San Pedro Neighborhood Council supports CF 20-1210 to exempt the Emergency Management Department from managed hiring freeze for the position of Assistant Gen Manager, three (3) Emergency Management Coordinator Il's and four (4) Emergency Management Coordinator 1's, plus any and all future vacancies that will put full operation of department and their response to Angelenos at risk. We oppose cutting the budget of the Emergency Management Department below levels of FY 2O19/2O. This is an essential service department dedicated to ensuring public safety in the event of earthquakes, wildfires, floods, civil disturbances, terrorist attacks and pandemics. Furthermore, we recommend that a minimum of \$5 million of the \$150 Million, taken from LAPD, should be directed to the public safety sector, Emergency Management Department. The purpose is to rebuild and ensure the EMD has the resources and personnel necessary to maintain at full operational status, including 24/7 operation of the city's Emergency Operation Center.
